Delta Aquatics, a year round competitive swim club that has operated for over 20 years, is seeking multiple part-time assistant coaches to join our staff working with the 11-12, 13-14 and Senior training groups. Based in Oswego, Illinois, in the western suburbs of Chicago, we are looking for candidates who are passionate about swimming, focused on swimmer development, and enjoy working with children and teens.

In addition to being reliable and a good communicator, the ideal candidates will possess high ethical standards and will be as invested in our swimmers' character and personal development as they are in their competitive swim development.

Responsibilities

- Assist lead coaches with practice planning and on-deck delivery
- Provide age- and skill-appropriate training and feedback with an emphasis on individual growth, teamwork, and competitive technique, including stroke mechanics, starts, turns, and race skills.
- Create an engaging, positive training environment and enforce/follow all Safe Sport policies
- Communicate effectively with athletes, families, and staff
- Support meet operations, including entries, on-deck coaching, and session coverage
- Participate in and promote Delta team activities, community service, and social events.
- Model team values, sportsmanship, and athlete well-being

Qualifications

- The ideal candidate will have competitive swimming experience, coaching experience, and USA Swimming coach credentials
 - For Senior group assignments, previous coaching experience required
 - For age group assignments, at least one year of coaching and/or swim lesson instruction
- Maintain all USA Swimming coach membership requirements, including safety courses and background check
- Thorough knowledge of competitive swimming and stroke mechanics
- Ability to coach and motivate swimmers with a positive approach
- Enthusiastic, energetic, strong role model, team-oriented, dependable, good communicator
- Availability to work evenings and weekends, including meets
- US citizen or current visa authorization to work in the United States

Compensation:

These part-time Assistant Coach positions are hourly, averaging 10-15 hours per week, with 1-2 swim meet weekends per month. Competitive hourly pay is based upon experience. Delta Aquatics covers the costs of required certifications and USA Swimming membership, and reimburses approved professional development fees and mileage.
