



Officials Reimbursement Program

Delta Aquatics recognizes that having a well-staffed roster of USA Swimming certified officials (Stroke and Turn, Starters, Referees, and Computer Admin) is a sign of a well-rounded swim club and is vital to the ongoing health and success of our organization. In order to help assure that members are motivated to both become and remain certified officials, and to help ensure that they represent Delta well at swim meets, Delta will reimburse eligible officials the cost for the training clinic, USA Swimming non-athlete membership registration and background check required to become and remain a certified official. It is the policy of Delta Aquatics not to have the actual costs of officiating prevent anyone from joining our ranks, and therefore we have adopted this voluntary reimbursement program for those who wish to participate.

We are able to fund this due to the fundraising efforts of the team by hosting 3-4 multi-team meets each year. Delta hosts high quality meets and provides many opportunities for our athletes to swim for times that do not require traveling outside of Oswego. Typically we host over 25 sessions at home! To do this we need to have many certified officials.

To be eligible for reimbursement, an official must have worked 10 or more sessions at meets hosted by Delta, and 4 or more sessions at meets hosted by other clubs, during the period from September 1 through August 31. At the end of this period, those officials who wish to be reimbursed can submit for reimbursement using the form below. A credit will be applied to your swim team invoice within 30 days of when your request is received.

New for 24-25 and beyond

Delta Aquatics recognizes the dedication and hard work that officials put into supporting our swim meets. As a token of appreciation and to help ease any financial strain, we will credit back 1 swimmer's paid event fees for the meet sessions officials work. This ensures that our officials are both valued and supported, reinforcing our sense of community and teamwork within the club.

Delta Aquatics will credit back meet fees to family accounts for meets worked:

- For each session of a meet worked by a registered Delta Aquatics official (home or away), 1 swimmer's paid event fees for one session of that meet will be credited back to their account.

Requirements for Reimbursement:

For all reimbursement, a copy of your OTS covering the required timeframe needs to be attached, along with a copy of the payment receipt or check for the reimbursement you are seeking. (Login to OTS on a computer to access your sessions.)

To be reimbursed for yearly registration or background checks your OTS must show at least 14 sessions worked, and at least 10 of those must be at Delta events (Friday Races time trials, Winter Classic, Chase the Dream and Regional Championships all count) in the preceding year to qualify.

To be reimbursed for a training you must have completed all training for the position and be successfully certified at the position prior to reimbursement.
