Please review the information below before completing your registration.


As of August 2024, our registrations are now processed through an enrollment system called Captyn. When you are ready to review class offerings and/or register, click the button below to complete your class review, selection and purchase.

You will be asked to establish an account and load a credit card in order to pay the registration fee and purchase a class. This is a new system, so everyone needs to create a new account. Please be sure your contact information is accurate.

All fees will be charged in full upon your submission and our acceptance of the registration request. You will also be presented with our waivers and questionnaires which provide important details about the student and participation. Registration confirmations and payment receipts are captured within your account and sent by email. You may access your deltaaquatics.captyn.com account at any time.

How to Enroll in a class in Captyn

Go to the Captyn website: <https://deltaaquatics.captyn.com/login>. If you are visiting the website for the first time, you will need to create an account.

Select "Create Your Account" and follow the directions. You are the account owner, so it is your information. Please be sure that your correct information is in the Captyn system, including your cell phone number. One of the advantages of Captyn is that we can **text message** you in case we have a weather closure or any other kind of emergency situation.

Once you have created an account, click on the "Sign In" button in the upper right corner of the screen. Your email is your ID.

To view the available classes, click on Browse & Register:

Enrolling in a class is a lot like making any purchase online. Choose the appropriate class. Your selected class will go into a cart, and you will enter your credit card number to pay for your classes. Captyn has the flexibility of taking Visa, Mastercard, American Express or Discover for payment, so all of you who prefer AmEx and Discover take note. You will receive confirmation once your enrollment is complete or if there is an issue with your credit card. Captyn is a secure system, so if you save your credit card information, it will make future enrollments easier.
