

POSITION TITLE: Lifeguard

REPORTS TO: Swim Lesson Coordinator

Delta Aquatics, a year round competitive swim club and swim lesson program, based out of Oswego East High School (Oswego, IL) is seeking lifeguards to join our swim lesson staff.

Lifeguards are used to supplement swim instructors, to ensure we are applying the most effective measures to keep our students safe by minimizing and eliminating hazardous situations or behaviors. The lifeguard monitors and supervises aquatic activities, ensures safety in the pool area and administers first aid or life saving techniques when needed.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE: [The list below is not intended to be all-inclusive.]

- Report to work on time and with appropriate safety equipment and uniform. Expectation of professionalism, presenting a confident appearance, ready to act or assist members all times.
- Ensure and enforce the most effective measures are in place to keep our students safe.
- Provide constant surveillance of swimmers during designated hours.
- Administer and coordinated emergency first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and uses automated external defibrillator (AED) when needed.
- Keep the pool area clean and orderly to ensure the safety of our students.
- Ensure that the rules and regulations of the swimming pool are followed to maintain a safe swimming environment.
- Perform regularly scheduled light cleaning maintenance duties, i.e., returning equipment to storage, pool configuration changes and general clean up tasks as assigned, or needed.
- Notify supervisor of any faulty equipment or unsafe conditions.
- Assist with programming needs and perform other related duties as assigned.
- Create a positive and energetic atmosphere for our swimmers. Have FUN!

REQUIREMENTS: [The requirements listed below are representative of the minimum education and/or hands-on experience necessary to perform each essential responsibility.]

- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- Ability to read, write & understand written directions.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Prior experience preferred.
- Must possess the following certifications from the Red Cross or other equivalent agency: lifeguard training, CPR, AED, and first aid.
 - Must be physically able to rescue someone from the water.

COMPENSATION:

This is an hourly position, consisting of 2-4 evenings a week (Monday through Thursday), and the rate will be commensurate with experience, starting at \$17/hour. We offer you a consistent schedule (you will know your schedule 8 weeks in advance), uniform, and we are flexible with adjusting working hours around school/sports schedules.
